Republican National Hispanic Assembly of Florida Announces Michelle Archival as Faith and Family Advisor

Miami, FL - June 16, 2026 — The Republican National Hispanic Assembly of Florida (RNHA Florida) is expanding its leadership team as part of its broader 2026 strategy to deepen engagement with Hispanic families and faith communities across the state.
